You may have recently received a leaflet through your door from the Animal Protection Party (APP) candidate. This litany of smears and falsehoods has two main contentions.

Firstly, it refers in an extremely aggressive manner to the support that I have given to Huntingdon Life Sciences. To this I reply that I have been proud to protect local jobs and stand up for local businesses in my constituency, including HLS. Furthermore, I am also proud, locally and in Parliament, to have spoken out against the activists who have attempted to bully, terrorise and intimidate hundreds of my constituents, sometimes in their own homes. If elected, I will continue this important work.

Secondly the leaflet follows claims, printed in a national newspaper last year, concerning my Parliamentary expense claims. I have consistently denied that I did anything wrong in making these claims and have since had all the relevant receipts cleared by the (independent) Legg audit of MPs expenses. The APP leaflet is accordingly now in the hands of my solicitors for action to be taken.

Finally, I find it somewhat ironic to note that I am berated in the APP leaflet for claiming for gates on my home – given that I had a brick thrown through my kitchen window in Alconbury by animal rights ‘campaigners’. A package of security measures, instituted after consultation with the Police, did include repair work to the gates. But let me make the position clear here: I paid for the installation of the gates, but I claimed for their repair and upgrade as I was permitted to do by the Parliamentary authorities on security grounds.

The question to be asked here is – what price democracy?
